

Safe Environment Education Program (English)

This is a two hour workshop and part of Level I Certification for Catholic school teachers and catechists. It was previously titled “Legal Issues” and is available upon request for parish groups and schools. The training is for adults who supervise, teach, drive, care for or minister to children, youth or vulnerable adults. Parish compliance training does not replace this class, although this class may be taken in place of parish compliance training. The goals of the session: to gain motivation, confidence and knowledge of how to include safety into their curriculum and environment. The importance of the subject should be sufficient to override fears about teaching it. Adults who attend will learn to identify physical and behavioral indicators of abuse as well as risk factors and protective factors. Participants will come away with understanding the purpose and importance of Arizona’s Mandatory Reporting law.
